The Lifelong Learning Programme: education and training opportunities for all

The European Commission's Lifelong Learning Programme enables people at all stages of their lives to take part in stimulating learning experiences, as well as helping to develop the education and training sector across Europe. The programme funds a range of actions including exchanges, study visits and networking activities. Projects are intended not only for individual students and learners, but also for teachers, trainers and all others involved in education and training.

There are four sub-programmes which fund projects at different levels of education and training:

- **Comenius** for schools
- **Erasmus** for higher education
- **Leonardo da Vinci** for vocational education and training
- **Grundtvig** for adult education

Grundtvig actions: Workshops

Workshops enable adult learners to participate in learning events and seminars taking place in a European country other than their own. Workshops bring together individuals or small groups of learners (10-20 people) from several countries for their personal development and learning needs. Learners are also encouraged to share their competences and insights with others. However, workshops are not intended to provide vocational training for professionals.

Workshops are organized on many different topics, including:

- visual arts, music, the environment, creativity, numeracy, mathematics, science, and other topics which are not too heavily dependent on foreign language competence;
- language-learning, particularly for people wishing to build on basic competences (or improve in specialised areas) in the language of the country where the workshop is organised, notably where this is a less widely-used and less taught language;
- discussion groups on issues of common interest across Europe, with a view to stimulating greater interest in European affairs among the adult population;
- active citizenship and intercultural dialogue;
- health education.

The workshop addresses the mobility as a fundamental tool through which to promote a deeper sense of identity and citizenship by developing new language and intercultural skills, strengthening human capital, increasing employment opportunities, creating benefits to both the worker to employer.
